Fadilah (2010:37) made on the occasion of the 50th anniversary of the founding of the Fatah Unsur. His speech is in the spirit of some of the above-mentioned articles from the Women’s Rights Movement of that period. A woman rights

activist, Fadilah (2010:23) mentioned that women in Indonesia were involved in a variety of activities, such as involvement in student organization, student union, feminist movement, and feminist activists. He stressed that these movements were closely connected with each other. While students may have been the beginning, Fadilah (2010:23) added that the activism of women in the military were also significant. A woman activist who has been active in feminist movement in the context of Indonesian political thought is Pranawati (2001:244). In his speech at the opening of the Fatah Unsur 50th anniversary, she was said to be the founder of the Feminist Movement in Indonesia. In the context of Indonesian literature, he has been active in the feminist movement, and she was a key figure in the movement of the 1960s.[69] Pranawati wrote about women as subjects in Indonesia during the period of colonialism, and also in the postcolonial period. She was involved in the political struggle of the 1990s for women's empowerment, which is reflected in her works such as 'Feminist Movement in the Context of Indonesian Political Thought' (2001), 'The Role of Women in the Indonesian Nation' (2005) and 'Women, the new elites in Indonesia' (2006) The role of the 1970s feminists is reflected in 'The Role of Women in the Indonesian Nation' (2005:54), where she emphasized the role of the women's movement in the nation building. The new women leaders in the 1980s have become leaders of the nation. She (82157476af
